Buses are **wheelchair lift** equipped and drivers are trained to provide assistance.



Priority seating is available on all buses for senior citizens and people with disabilities.



Controlled **service animals** are welcome. Pets are permitted in a carrier only.



Buses are equipped with bike racks.

HOW TO RIDE

Check bus route times and stop locations.

Arrive at the bus stop at least 5 minutes early.

Schedule may vary as much as 5 minutes.

If needed, ask the driver for assistance.

Press the bell bar or pull the cord to signal the driver about a block before the bus stop.

Give priority seating to seniors and people with disabilities when required.

Use flashlight when it is dark.

BUS ETIQUETTE

- No smoking, eating, or drinking.
- Shirts and shoes required
- Headphones only with personal data devices
- Pets allowed in carry cases only
- Remain seated
- No boisterous or other disturbing behaviors
- No unnecessary talking with drivers.

Lost & Found Items — will be donated to charity if not claimed within 15 days.

Children under 10 – must have an adult 16 yrs or older with them. 10-12 yrs may ride bus alone if there is an adult at the place of departure and arrival.
