

Mt. Hood Corridor CPO

Minutes December 2, 2010 7pm

In attendance: 3 Officers, 7 members

The Meeting was called to order at 7pm by David Fulton, Acting Chair. The November 2010 minutes were approved 9-0.

Betsy LeBarge's land use application was approved by the County with minor conditions.

AT&T has applied to place a cell tower on an existing tower on the Big Eddy BPA Power Line on Crutcher's Bench. It looks as though no light is needed on the tower. The tower will be 135 feet tall. This location is one recommended earlier by MHC-CPO.

The MHC-CPO authorized the board to engage in continued communication consistent with concerns regarding past applications. Generally, we are in favor of the proposed location. The above motion passed 10-0

David Fulton, Treasurer, reported that the November balance was \$317.60. We received \$6 in refreshment donations and the balance is now \$323.60
