

Mt. Hood Corridor CPO

MINUTES April 7, 2011, 2011 7pm

Dorman Room of the Community Center, 24500 E. Salmon River Road

Attending: 4 board members, 9 members, Paul Winsinger and 3 others from Water Environmental Services, and Lt. Behan, Clackamas County Sherriff's Department

The meeting was called to order at 1900 hours by Roy Bellows, Chair.

March minutes were approved with the misprinted enumeration omitted.

Dave Fulton discussed county and other correspondence.

Dave Fulton gave the Treasurer's report: starting balance of 323.60 and ending at 327.60 with refreshment donations.

Will Behan reported that the Sheriff's Department is still trying to get feedback from BPA and BLM with the goal of road access in emergencies.

Janine Bertram reported on the April 2 regional CPO meeting.

It was moved and seconded that MHC-CPO be involved (along with Firwood, Rhododendron, and Eagle Creek CPOs) at an earlier point of the planning process for timber management of county public lands.

Dave Fulton gave an update on the Cell tower for this area. CascadiaPM expects the new cell tower to be on the BPA power lines in 2+ months. . This is the site suggested to CascadiaPM and AT&T by MHC-CPO and Don't Cell Us Out. 2 environmental studies are needed: 1 BPA and one BLM. There may be an opportunity for public comment

Amy Kyle and others from Water/Environment services reported on sewage issues and river quality, specifically as a result of the flood in

January of 2011. The design and permitting of the operating plant will be an ongoing issue.

2 citizens presented significant issues with code compliance and excessive fines.

CPO resolved 12-1 to invite code compliance to present at a CPOmeeting.

The CPO discussed community organization for sustainable timber harvest.
