Same here, Steve...a pleasure.

Turin and Sons is under contract to perform pothole patching and some skin patches on the full length of Road 20, from US Hwy 26 through to Still Creek Road (aka 2612, aka Road 12).

This work is scheduled to be completed this operating season, so within the next 6 weeks or so. Just as information, Turin also will be doing similar work on the Salmon River Road (aka 2618), Road 32 (aka 2632), and Lolo Pass Road (aka1800).

In addition, this summer we have already had roadside brushing done on Road 32 and Still Creek Road, and blading is scheduled to be done on those same roads starting next week. The 2656 Loop, down past Trillium Lake and around beyond Tamarack Quarry and back to the lake has also been brushed. Last fall, brushing was completed on Salmon River Road, Lolo Pass Road, 1825 and 1828.

Still Creek Road also benefited this summer from extensive ditch cleaning and shaping, and culvert catch basins were also cleaned.

So as you can see, we have been pretty busy with a wide range of road maintenance activities on the Mountain. I hope that folks will begin to see and enjoy some improvements in the local FS roads. It represents a significant allocation of our available resources...I sure hope to be able to continue the effort in future years.
