

**Rhododendron CPO  
Meeting Minutes  
10:30 am  
July 23, 2010**

**◆ Opened Meeting at 10:30 am**

President Sharon Lamoreaux welcomed and determined a quorum. There were five in attendance.

**◆ Read Minutes**

Since the meeting minutes from our last meeting on April 16<sup>th</sup>, 2011 was emailed to the community and posted at the Rhododendron post office there was a proposal to accept the meeting minutes as presented.

There were no additions, corrections or amendments to the April 16, 2011 minutes. Nancy Dougherty moved and Michelle Lamoreaux seconded the motion to accept the April 16<sup>th</sup> meeting minutes as posted.

**◆ Treasures Report**

Co-Treasurer's Merv and Barbara Novinger were absent. Carol Haugk graciously gave report in their absence. Currently the CPO checking account has a \$684.99 balance. Since the last meeting, Barbara Novinger wrote a \$100.00 check to Carol Haugk to reimburse her for supplies purchased to maintain the Rhododendron Memorial Garden. The portion allocated to the garden has an approximate balance of \$150.00.

This treasurer's report was unanimously accepted and submitted into this document.

**◆ Old Business**

**Rhododendron CPO Boundary Update**

Steve Graeper has been heading the committee to expand the boundaries of the current CPO. Due to a scheduling conflict, he was unable to attend this meeting but wanted to relay the message that he continues to work on this expansion. The obstacle continues to be whether Government Camp supports the release of the MHFC cabins to their West into the Rhododendron CPO. Government Camp has not given Steve a date for their upcoming meeting so he can present this boundary proposal to them. Nancy Dougherty wants to know if it would be feasible to move forward with a

boundary change now to include the Faubion Loop and Woodlands areas now since they are interested in joining the Rhododendron CPO. Perhaps pursuing the MHFC cabins in the future could be a second phase? Kevin Liburdy and Sharon Lamoreaux mentioned the importance of including Steve Graeper into this conversation since he has spent so much time on this process to date and there is no desire to forfeit the work done on this project.

### **Rhododendron Signage Update**

Sharon Lamoreaux reported that Jeanine Brashear, our contact for the Mt. Hood Scenic Byways signage notified her that funding for this project has been fully allocated. Now the timing and scheduling for the project to begin is being ironed out. Sharon hopes Jeanine will be available to present this project at the next Rhododendron CPO meeting in October. Sharon also encourages local artisans to bid on working on this project.

### **Rhododendron Memorial Garden Update**

Carol Haugk reported on the work done to date on the garden and the additional plantings of shrubs and small trees. Michelle Lamoreaux, the Novinger's and Carol Haugk have created a work schedule to maintain the garden. President Sharon Lamoreaux commends these individuals for their dedication and hard work in the garden as the garden looks better than it ever has.

### **◆ Other Old Business**

#### **Rhododendron Trash Pick-up Update**

Carol Haugk reported on the effort and time spent in picking up garbage throughout the Rhododendron area. The attendees of this meeting commended Carol for her dedication in doing this work. She does this pick up on a regular basis.

#### **Mountain Bike project at Timberline**

Sharon Lamoreaux reported that the mountain bike project proposal for the Timberline area has been shelved but there is the potential of new activity on this as early as November, 2011.

**Rhododendron Fall Garbage Pick-up**

Carol Haugk is organizing the fall Rhododendron garbage pick up and will be notifying the community of the date and time in case anyone would like to volunteer to help her in this effort.
